



WINSTON CHURCHILL



It was May 10, 1940, and the freedom of Great Britain was in doubt. The time was at hand for the King of England to make a decision. Which man would he summon to become the next Prime Minister? The King wanted someone else, but in the end he chose Winston Churchill to lead Britain through their darkest days as he saved Democracy in Great Britain and the free world.

Some 23 years later, President Kennedy and the Congress of the

United States made Sir Winston Churchill an Honorary Citizen of the United States on April 9, 1963, insuring that our school could be named Winston Churchill. The worldly leadership of Sir Winston has only been enhanced by our school and the tradition of excellence it has displayed since opening in 1966. Our 27 State Championships and 2 Lone Star Cups in UIL Athletics marks us as one of the finest schools in the State. As Sir Winston said, "Destiny is what I believe in, Destiny commands we must obey". The man and the school have lived by this motto, and we continue that tradition of destiny and achievement.

Sir Winston Churchill's life history is a part of the school's legacy. The names of the various groups you see tonight are all linked to him: Chargers, Lancer Dancers, Grenadier Drill Team, the Rampant Lion mascot. The original Band uniforms were modeled after the Queen's Guard, the Guards used to protect Buckingham Palace. The words we sing as our school song were penned by Cindy Harrington, WCHS class of '68 in 1966. The song's name is Rule Britannia, originally written in 1740 by Thomson and David Mallet.

Sir Winston Churchill is celebrated in many books and movies about him, two of which were recent HBO movies depicting several important times in his life. During his lifetime he received 37 medals from 12 different countries. In 1953, Sir Winston was awarded the Nobel Prize for Literature and invested as a Knight of the Garter by Queen Elizabeth II.

When Sir Winston died on January 24, 1965, he was given an honor reserved rarely for anyone outside of the British monarchy. His body lay in state for three days at Westminster Hall and then he was given a State Funeral at St. Paul's Cathedral.

The Sir Winston S. Churchill Memorial Wall represents an excellent look at his life. About 50 items were donated from the personal Churchill collection of Donald E. Jakeway. They were presented on behalf of the Churchill Centre of South Texas and Mr. Jakeway. The "Sir Winston S. Churchill Scholarship Fund" was also established and has given financial assistance to several Churchill High School students.

Tradition & Pride of Charger Football – 2018*

The Churchill Chargers are entering their 52nd year! There have been some outstanding teams throughout the years. The overall record is 358 wins, 209 losses and 11 ties. There have been 24 playoff teams, including two state semifinalists and one team that captured the state championship in 1976 with a perfect 15-0 record.

Charger teams have been privileged to play in front of live television coverage and have performed in front of better than 22,000 fans on many occasions. There have been games played in the Astrodome, Memorial Stadium in Austin, Rice Stadium in Houston, College Station and in 1996, the Chargers played in the first ever playoff game in the Alamodome in front of 18,000 fans. Over the years there have been packed stadiums in the local area. One of the more memorable games occurred in 1981, when some 19,000 fans crowded into North East Stadium and sat on the slopes of the gym to see the Chargers' regional contest. In 1999, Churchill beat Clark in the Annual Gucci Bowl at the Alamodome. This game was the inaugural game of the Annual Texas Football Classic. A great spirit has always existed among Charger teams. This spirit has been in the stands as well, and the two together have contributed greatly to the success these teams have achieved over the past 51 years.

The past 51 years have also seen some outstanding individuals. There have been many players who have been recognized at the city and state level, and many of those have gone on to play college and professional football. Three, Mike Norment, Andy Hrncir and Carl Gustafson, became head high school football coaches. Gary Kelly, our starting QB in 1972, became CEO & Chairman of Southwest Airlines!
